27th August 2007



Desmond presented EEP workshops at the All Elders Convention of the Western Cape Circuit (ELCSA) on the 25th -26th August. There were about 180 delegates (Pastors, Theologians, Doctorates and Elders). The workshop included an ETS Introduction, the Elders Leadership workshop and the Tithing workshop.
